



- Students are responsible for keeping their room, and shared spaces clean. Your homestay is not responsible to clean up after you.
- Show respect to your homestay and your homestay family. Be polite, say please and thank you. This will help you build a strong relationship with your homestay family
- If you damage or break items at your homestay, you are required to replace them or pay for damage.
- When you first arrive to homestay, you have a two-week trial period, during which you can change homestay without giving two weeks notice. **After your trial period, you must provide your homestay and Student Services Manager, two-week's notice before moving out.**
- Provide your homestay your cell phone number and ensure you have their cell phone number as well. Communicate regularly with your homestay, especially about where you are, if you are going to miss dinner, and for all emergencies
- For students 18 and under, you have a curfew of 10 PM on weeknights, and 11:30 PM on weekends. If you are going to be late, please inform your homestay family. Drinking alcohol/smoking is not permitted in homestay.
- If you wish to have a sleepover outside of your homestay, you must inform your homestay and Student Services Manager BEFORE the date of the sleepover and provide homestay with a full itinerary (name of supervising adult, address of where they will be staying, phone number and email address of supervising adult).
- If you wish to have a friend over to your homestay, you MUST FIRST ask your homestay permission, prior to having a guest over. Only after your homestay parent agrees to this are you allowed to have a guest over. You must follow all rules and guidelines regarding guest policy set by your homestay family
- Just as you are allowed to ask to move out of a homestay, your homestay family is also allowed to ask you to move out. If you are disrespectful, break homestay rules, or generally do not behave, your homestay can ask for you to be removed. If this happens at 3 homestays, you are removed from our homestay program permanently.
- When moving out of a homestay, your room must be left CLEAN. Furniture should be left as you found it. If you leave garbage in your room, your account will be charged a \$50.00 cleaning fee.
- If you are 18 years old or under, and under Braemar Custodianship, you MUST live in a Braemar Homestay. If you are under the custodianship of another adult, Canadian citizen, or over 18, you are not required to live in a Braemar Homestay.
